Assessments and reports

Children in Year 2 and Year 6 sit end of key stage assessments (SATS). Pupils in Early Years complete the EYFS curriculum by the end of the summer term. All other year groups have regular assessments including an end of year external assessment (GL assessments) to help teachers evaluate the progress of pupils. Parents will receive an annual report about their children's strengths, progress and achievements and be informed about any gaps in their children's progress and ways that they can help. Reports will focus on how well the child is progressing in terms of becoming secure in their learning.

Learning Journeys

At Noor UI Islam Primary School we believe it is hugely beneficial for children and parents to be aware of what they are learning. Therefore we have created these Learning Journeys to paint a unique picture of what a child knows and can do.

At the beginning of each year parents will receive a learning journal for the year that details the expected objectives that their child should meet by the end of that academic year.

The Learning Journey will also be used by pupils in school to self-assess and plan their learning effectively over the course of the year. This approach of giving children control and oversight of their learning is key in developing their 'metacognition' skills and has been shown to have a major impact on their success at school.
